

I think in the last 200 years we have failed to give a good answer to the evolutionists and we have allowed them to take over our thinking processes in our school systems, museums and everything else and it is about time we put up fight!

In this blog i will give a general perspective to evolution

Does it really matter what we believe?

There are four great questions that man tries to answer in his lifetime

1. Who am I?
2. Where did I come from?
3. Why am I here?
4. Where am I going when I die?

The way you answer these questions is determined by the way you view the world

There are two ways to look at this world

1. Humanist world view - a big bang made this world from nothing. Man is God and answers to no one.
2. Creationist world view – there is incredible design there must be a designer (God). God is God and judges all men.

If evolution is true how would you answer the four great questions?

1. Who am I – you are nothing important, and you're a piece of protoplasm that washed up on the beach. You are not valuable
2. Where did I come from – you come from essentially a rock 20 billion years ago
3. Why are we here – there is no purpose to life, anything goes.
4. Where I am going when I die – you're going to the grave and nowhere further

The bible says that in the beginning God created the heaven and the earth (Gen 1:1). If creation is true then that will change the answers to the four great questions in a dramatically. These two views, evolution and creation, are polar opposites and somebody is wrong.

What is extremely important in understanding evolution is actually defining the terms. Evolution has many meanings and can be generalised as follows.

1. Cosmic evolution – the origin of time, space and matter, i.e. Big Bang.
2. Chemical evolution – the origin of higher elements from hydrogen.
3. Stellar and planetary evolution – origin of stars and planets.
4. Organic evolution – origin of life (evolution of non-living material)
5. Macroevolution – changing from one kind of animal to another.

6. Micro-evolution – variation within the kind.

Only micro-evolution has been observed. 1-5 is either based on very poor evidence or is religious in some form. Much greater discussion of these meanings will be discussed at later time, if God wills!
